The Annual Meeting of the Association is held on Thursday 27 April 2017, during the 16<sup>th</sup> European Meeting on Supercritical Fluids in Lisbon, Portugal.

It is opened by the President, Professor Elisabeth Badens, at the end of the afternoon session at 5:30 PM. She welcomed the participants. After signature of the participant list and after counting the number of absentees represented by participants, the President declares that the *quorum* is met and that the Assembly can be held according to the Society status.

##### **1/ Annual Report 2016:**

ISASF has co-organized two meetings in 2016:

- The 15<sup>th</sup> European Meeting on Supercritical Fluids, 8-11 May 2016, Essen - Germany. The President thanks the Meeting organizers and more particularly Prof. Eckhard Weidner and Prof. Marcus Petermann for the great organization.

- The 3<sup>rd</sup> International Symposium on Aerogels, 22-23 September 2016, Sophia-Antipolis – France.

## **2/ 2016 Financial results:**

A financial balance sheet and the report of the auditor (see “Appendix 1”) are distributed to the audience. The President gives the word to the Treasurer, Dr Michel PERRUT, who comments the text written by Carsten ZETL, Auditor (absent to the Annual Meeting). Following the two congresses organized in 2016, the 2016 activity of the Society resulted in a financial surplus of 5,838 euros while a deficit of 13,136 euros was recorded in 2015. At the end of 2016, the net reserves amounts are 53,467 euros. It can be concluded that the financial situation of the society is good and that the society is disinterested and honestly managed.

After a short discussion, the Assembly approves unanimously both the general and the financial reports and gives *quitus* to the Board. On behalf of all the board members the President thanks the attendees for their confidence.

## **3/ Ph. D. ISASF Award 2016 /Award 2016 for the best poster**

Poster title: **Insights Into the Evolution of Hydrogen Bonding from Ambient to Supercritical Conditions**

The **4<sup>th</sup> International Seminar on AEROGELS** will be held in September 2018 in Hamburg, Germany. The chairmen will be Prof. Irina Smirnova and Dr. Michel PERRUT.
